- <u>Veterans Service</u>: **Chair Dave Lord** is taking another online course to help him work on VA claims. He stated that the VA is relooking at some of their disability claims to see if any of the new criteria that has recently been authorized applies to those veterans who may have been denied prior to the adoption of this new criteria.
- <u>Youth Activities</u>: **Chair James Grisham** mentioned that the Spokane Indians have two military appreciation nights on their schedule this year, one in May and one in August.
