Grand National Winner receives \$1,500. Winners in each grade level will receive:

1st Place \$1,000 2nd Place \$ 750 3rd Place \$ 500

Each national winner will receive an attractive plaque citing his/her achievement and every entrant judged at the national level receives a certificate of recognition.

94th FRA / 89th LA FRA National Conventions

The 2022 National Convention is being hosted by various Branches and Units in the Southeastern Region. It will be held October 16-22, 2022 at the Hyatt Regency's Wynfrey Hotel at 1000 Riverchase Galleria, Birmingham, AL. Room Rates are \$116 per night plus 14% tax and a Tourist fee of \$2. The deadline for making reservations is September 18, 2022.
